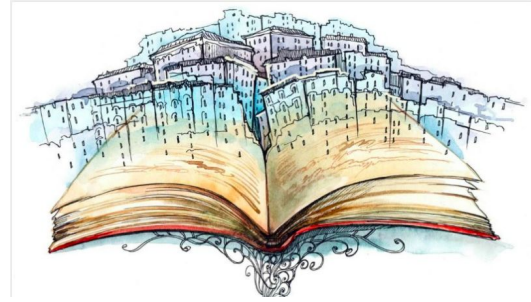


Short Story Posters

So far, we've read a variety of short stories together. Now, you will break into small groups to compose a poster where you will closely examine the following for one of those stories:



Plot -

Exposition
Rising Action
Climax
Resolution/Denouement

**this will help you write your summary!*

Conflict -

Internal or External?
What is it?
Man VS Man
Man VS Nature
Man VS Self
Man VS Society

Characters -

Describe key characters.
Who is the antagonist?
Who or what is the protagonist?
Character types - Are they dynamic or static?
What is the point of view? First or third person?

Setting -

When and where does the story take place?

Theme -

What is the moral of the story? What message is the author trying to send?

Tone - What is the author's attitude toward the subject?

Mood - What emotion do you feel when you read the story?

Figurative Language -

Find at least two in your story:

Simile
Metaphor
Personification
Hyperbole

Summary -

In 5-7 sentences, summarize your story.

Draw a picture/image -

Scene, setting, symbol, or character

Reader response -

Connect the story with something in your own life. How can you relate? Have you ever experienced anything similar? Make one connection for each group member.

Also include the title, author, and names of group members on your poster.
